What is AAIGK? AA Inner Group Korea helps carry the message by maintaining a website and hotline, distributing AA info; keeps and updates a list of AA meetings; and maintains an inventory of AA literature. And organize AA related events and activities that groups may not have the resources to do themselves.



Alcoholics Anonymous Inter-Group Korea (AAIGK) is the equivalent of a local central office. We provide services to the English speaking AA communities living in Seoul and other parts of Korea. We run a volunteer telephone answering service; keep and update a list of AA meetings; maintain an inventory of AA literature; and organize AA related events that groups may not have the resources to do themselves.

P.I. Committee. Public information is important in carrying the message. Some of the duties of P.I. are to distribute pamphlets in hospitals and institutions, civic centers, etc. It also focuses on public awareness of what A.A. is about. It is vital to the growth of A.A. as a whole.

Alcoholics Anonymous Planning Committee (AAPC). This committee was formed to determine the feasibility of opening an Alano Club (or the possibility of an office space with room for meetings) here in Seoul. Many issues have come up with the USO Club, though we are very grateful for them allowing us to use the facilities. Some of the issues are that the USO is closed during all Korean holidays.
